PRACTICAL POINTERS

Find useful everyday tips in this NEW section of our GOC newsletter.

With spring around the corner, here are a few Garden Tips:

- **Natural Insecticide** – Add onions and garlic to a jar of water, let it stand for a week, and spray plants with it
- **Tinting Flowers** – Mix some food coloring in warm water and put flower stems in the solution. Stems will absorb the color and tint the flowers
- **Caring for Sick Plants** – A tablespoon of castor oil chased by water brings sick plants out of their slump
- **Killing Weeds** – Pour boiling salt water on grass or weeds growing between sections of the sidewalk (be careful doing this by flowers!)
- **Grow Parsley** – Wet a clean sponge and sprinkle with parsley. Place near a window and you will soon have a large clump of foliage

German Chocolate Cake Mix Bars

From the Kitchen of GOC member Mary Schumacher

- 14 oz. bag of Kraft caramels
- 2/3 cup evaporated milk
- 1 box German Chocolate cake mix
- 3/4 cup melted butter
- 1 cup walnuts, chopped
- 1 cup chocolate chips

Grease a 9 x 13 pan and preheat oven to 350 degrees. Melt the caramels in 1/3 cup of the milk and set aside. Combine dry cake mix, butter, 1/3 cup evaporated milk, and nuts. Stir until the dough holds together. Press half of the dough into the pan. Bake for 6 minutes. Remove from oven and spread with caramel, then sprinkle with chocolate chips. Crumble the remaining unbaked dough over the top of the chocolate chips, then place pan back in oven and bake for another 20 minutes.
